Almost 300 riders raced the first event of the 2006 "TOI/W" Tour of Illinois and Wisconsin race series and second event of the WILL 2006 Rider of the Year competition. A great day of racing, with just a bit of cool weather, a slight breeze and just a touch of rain during the Cat 1, 2, 3 final event.

Between 9 & 10am 30 Junior age 18 and under riders raced the one mile course completing either a 5 or 10 mile race, nice going. To the Parents and Guardians who brought the kids be sure you are wearing enough warm clothes while you watch them having fun racing. All the juniors rode great some were a little faster today.

36 Women raced during the day, most in the combined Women's race and a few in other age and category races. Peithman and Palmquist showed some great finishing speed when the women's pack sprinted to the finish line. The petite Sarah Huang raced Junior and women cat 3/4. I wonder if some of these non-sprinters can break away, perhaps on the hill next week.

Talking of Breakaways, James MacDonald lapped the Masters 60 ~ 80+ field. Must have been listening well to Brent Emery's race tactics.

It appears that the "motors" in Masters 50+ rode just fast enough to place well because you will see the same names in 40+ and some in 30+ where they had a good chance of being trounced. Farrell celebrating year 25 placed 1<sup>st</sup> in 50 and 2<sup>nd</sup> in 40+.

77 Cat 4 riders had a good safe race with a steady fast pace during their 45 minutes and 2 laps. All your training is paying off.

Cat 3 racers. The gutter is no place to be moving up in the field, it is usually where the crashes start. If you are in the back of a 50-rider field with one lap to go, well if you make the front you probably have nothing left for the uphill sprint. You need to move up when the field has moved to one side of the road. Of course everyone may try to move up so those in the front need to go a little faster to maintain.

Cat 1 - 3 race was fast with numerous break attempts. Then John Van Susteren LAPT, Reid Mumford Athletes by Design, Brandon **Gavic** Wheel & Sprocket, Scott Pearson Bike Shop/Tin Fish and Morgan Wiswall Wheel & Sprocket make a breakaway that sticks to the finish. A fast field sprint was won by Reed Tanger Turin.
